PPIHC is excited to announce that our 2018 partner for Technical Inspection, Rehv's TechWorks, is returning for 2019. This software allows the PPIHC (or other series) to streamline race vehicle inspections and verify compliance with series standards. From preliminary compliance to post-race checks, TechWorks allows tech teams to enter and verify every spec in real time, using mobile, state-of-the-art tools. The PPIHC will be using this strategy and software for the 2019 Technical Inspection and Event.

Technical Inspection Reminders:

- Technical Inspection will be held at The Broadmoor World Arena Parking Lot C (located at [3185 Venetucci Blvd, Colorado Springs, CO 80906](#)) on Monday, June 24, 2019 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. PPIHC Technical Inspection is free and open to the public.
- Prior to Technical Inspection, competitors must complete Registration in the Breckenridge Room at Hotel Eleganté (located at [2886 South Circle Dr., Colorado Springs, CO 80906](#)). Competitors will not be able to go through Tech Inspection without first completing Registration.
- Registration at Hotel Eleganté will be open **for Rookie Competitors and Rookie Orientation Mentors only** on Sunday, June 23, 2019 from 5:00pm-7:00pm.
- Registration for all PPIHC Veterans will take place on Monday, June 24, 2019 from 8:00am-5:00pm at Hotel Eleganté.

- During Registration, competitors will be given a Tech Folder that they must bring to Technical Inspection at The Broadmoor World Arena. Competitors will not be allowed to begin Technical Inspection without their Tech Folder in hand.
- At Registration, competitors will also be given a Gran Turismo windshield banner or helmet visor sticker. All competitors/entries will be responsible for the application of the Gran Turismo banner in the specified location before receiving an official Tech sticker. All competitors entered in the 2019 Broadmoor Pikes Peak International Hill Climb, brought to you by Gran Turismo, will be required to display this Gran Turismo banner on their vehicle and/or person during all practice and qualifying sessions and on Race Day. - All teams must have the ability and be prepared to raise their vehicle upon request during Technical Inspection.
- All competitors in 2019 will be required to present tires appropriate for all possible weather conditions on Pikes Peak (including wet roads and cold temperatures) at Technical Inspection. Tires must be presented at the scales.
- Only one race vehicle will be inspected during Technical Inspection. No back up vehicle inspections will be conducted at that time.
- Each participant is required to reserve a space on the front left and front right side of the vehicle for PPIHC decals noting that the vehicle has passed the PPIHC's Technical Inspection requirements. These decals must be displayed at all times while participating in Race Week activities.

Technical Inspection Schedule, Monday, JUNE 24, 2019

- The Technical Inspection schedule is broken down by Division. In order to avoid long backups and delays, vehicles may not be presented for inspection prior to their scheduled time unless the previously scheduled Division has completed inspection. If the inspection of a Division takes longer than scheduled, the next Division will line up behind the final vehicle of the previously scheduled Division.

Car Technical Inspection Schedule:

- 9:00am-10:00am – Rookie Car Competitors
- 10:00am-10:30am – Unlimited
- 10:30am-11:45am – Time Attack 1

- 11:45am-12:15pm – Porsche Pikes Peak Trophy by Yokohama
- 12:15pm-1:00pm – Open Wheel Class
- 1:00pm-1:45pm – Pikes Peak Open
- 1:45pm-2:30pm – Exhibition

Motorcycle Technical Inspection Schedule:

- 8:30am – Rookie Motorcycles line up for Technical Inspection
- 9:00am-10:00am – Rookie Motorcycle Competitors
- 10:00am-2:30pm – Veteran Motorcycle Competitors
(Arrive any time within these 4 hours, regardless of division.)

Mandatory Meetings for Competitors:

- 11:00am-3:30pm – **Mandatory Rookie Orientation**
 - **Location:** All Rookie Competitors will meet at the Pikes Peak International Hill Climb [Start Line](#).
 - Any Rookie competitor who fails to attend the mandatory Rookie Orientation and/or the Riders/Drivers meeting will not be allowed to practice or qualify until they are authorized to do so by the Director of Competition, Assistant Director of Competition, or a designee. Per the 2019 Rule Book, competitors may be fined and/or disqualified for missing the mandatory Rookie Orientation and/or the Riders/Drivers meeting.
- 4:30-6:00pm – **Mandatory All Riders/Drivers Meeting**
 - **Location:** Hotel Eleganté - Pikes Peak Room #1-#4 Joint Session
 - Riders/Drivers meetings will be limited to competitors and owner/crew chief. The meetings are closed to family members, spectators and the media. Failure to comply may result in penalties.
 - Any competitor who fails to attend the mandatory Riders/Drivers Meeting at Hotel Eleganté Monday, June 24th, will not be allowed to practice or qualify until they are authorized to do so by the Director of Competition, Assistant Director of Competition, or a designee. Per the 2019 Rule Book, competitors may be fined and/or disqualified for missing the mandatory Riders/Drivers Meeting.
- *2.7 Mandatory Meetings – During the course of the event there are mandatory sessions to include: technical inspection, competitor's (drivers and riders) meetings, rookie orientation (driver and rider), etc. Failure to attend or arrive at the scheduled time will result in fines, loss of practice time and/or exclusion from the event.*
