For 2020, Technical Inspection and Registration will be held on August 24th at The Broadmoor World Arena in Parking Lot C [3185 Venetucci Blvd, Colorado Springs, CO 80906](https://www.broadmoor.com/locations/3185-Venetucci-Blvd-Colorado-Springs-CO-80906)).

NEW FOR 2020: All competitors must register at their designated time before proceeding to Technical Inspection.

Registration/Crew Credentialing Schedule and Information

NEW FOR 2020: For COVID-19 safety reasons, the only form you will be able to sign at Registration is the Waiver of Liability. Prior to Registration, competitors MUST complete all paperwork referenced in bulletin 014 - 2020 Accepted Competitor Forms Checklist [HERE](#).

For the 2020 event, each driver will be allowed to have a total of six crew members in attendance at the event (4 complementary and two for purchase). Each driver will be given one (1) competitor credential and up to four (4) free crew credentials. ALL crew members must sign the online waiver [HERE](#) prior to registration. Each competitor is then allowed to purchase up to two (2) additional crew credentials for \$75 each – purchase [HERE](#).

NEW FOR 2020: There will be no onsite credential sales during Race Week.

Deadline for submitting online crew waivers / credential requests is Friday, August 21, 2020 at 10:00am MDT.

NEW FOR 2020: For COVID-19 safety reasons, no crew members are permitted at Registration, competitors must pick up and distribute all Crew Credentials listed under their name – be sure your crew signs the online waiver so the credentials can be released to you.

NEW FOR 2020: All Competitors must complete registration at their designated time.

After all documents have been verified and competitors have received their packet and credentials, they will be given a Tech folder that they must present at Technical Inspection. Competitors will not be allowed to begin Technical Inspection without their Tech folder in hand.

Technical Inspection Information and Schedule

PPIHC is excited to announce that [Rehv's TechWorks](#), is returning for Technical Inspection in 2020. This software allows the PPIHC (or other series) to streamline race vehicle inspections and verify compliance with series standards. From preliminary compliance to post-race checks, TechWorks allows tech teams to enter and verify every spec in real time, using mobile, state-of-the-art tools. The PPIHC will continue using this strategy and software for the 2020 Technical Inspection and Event.

Technical Inspection Reminders

- Competitors will not be able to go through Technical Inspection without first completing Registration.
- **NEW FOR 2020:** Only the competitor and six (6) crew members are allowed at Technical Inspection. Competitors and crew members will be instructed to remain with their vehicle at all times and not congregate with other teams, competitors, or crew members. No crew members are allowed in the Registration area. No crew members are allowed to attend Technical Inspection outside of the designated time slot. After the car has completed Technical Inspection, all crew members must leave the area.
- **NEW FOR 2020:** Prior to Technical Inspection, all competitors will be mailed a Gran Turismo windshield/helmet visor banner. All competitors/entries will be responsible for the application of the Gran Turismo banner in the specified location before receiving an Official 2020 PPIHC Tech decal. All competitors entered in the 2020 Broadmoor Pikes Peak International Hill Climb, brought to you by Gran Turismo, will be required to display this Gran Turismo banner on their vehicle and/or person during all Testing, Practice & Qualifying sessions and on Race Day.

- All teams must have the ability and be prepared to raise their vehicle upon request during Technical Inspection.
- All competitors in 2020 will be required to present tires appropriate for all possible weather conditions on Pikes Peak (including wet roads and cold temperatures) at Technical Inspection. Full sets of all tires must be presented at the scales.
- Only one race vehicle will be inspected during Technical Inspection. No back up vehicle inspections will be conducted at that time.

- If you have more than one racing suit, each will need to have the Official 98th Running Event Patch in place as specified. This will be checked at Tech Inspection where you are required to provide all suits you plan to wear throughout the week.
- Each participant is required to reserve a space on the front left and front right side of the vehicle for Official 2020 PPIHC Tech Decals noting that the vehicle has passed the Technical Inspection requirements. These decals must be displayed at all times while participating in Race Week activities. See Diagram A in the [2020 Rule Book](#).
- **NEW FOR 2020:** All vehicles needs to have the ability to move under their own power when requested.
