Time Attack 2 Production Record Attempt

The Director of Competition will have final authority on the eligibility of a vehicle for any Production Records. This record is for production-based two-wheel and four-wheel drive vehicles, that were issued a 17-digit VIN number by the manufacture and have a minimum homologation number of 500. It is the responsibility of the entrant to provide the proper homologation documentation if requested by a race official. Vehicles equipped with factory installed roll cages are not eligible to compete for the Time Attack 2 Production Record. All vehicles must be race ready in order to pass Technical Inspection.

Regardless of the division entered, competitors must adhere to the Time Attack 2 Production rules (i.e. fuel cell, DOT Tires, airbag disabled/removed, etc.) if they intend to compete for the Time Attack 2 Production record.

Competitors must declare their intent to make a record attempt in Time Attack 2 Production prior to June 1, 2021 by informing both Megan Leatham, Executive Director at Megan@ppihc.org, and Dan Skokan, Director of Competition at dskokan@ppihc.org.

Production SUV Record Attempt
