Summit House/Meal:

- Due to the ongoing construction project at the Summit, the PPIHC has arranged with Aramark and Pikes Peak-America's Mountain staff members for competitor access to the Summit House on Race Day.
- The Summit House will be open to Competitors for shelter and a meal. When inside the Summit House, face coverings are mandatory.

Food:

- The Summit House kitchen staff will have a full competitor list and will provide one meal per competitor on Race Day. The freshly prepared food items but will be distributed 'food truck style' and the concessionaire will be responsible for meeting all health requirements.

Face Coverings:

- All competitors will be given a disposable face mask once they exit their vehicle after finishing the race. Competitors will be encouraged to wear a face mask or cloth face covering at all times.

Media:

- PPIHC film crews/select media will be allowed to do post-race interviews with competitors using microphones/boom poles that allow for the competitor and interviewer to be 6' apart. The media will be asked to wear face masks or cloth face coverings when interacting with competitors. Competitors will not be allowed to touch/hold the microphone during interviews.

Results:

- TVs will be stationed in the Summit House, displaying live results.

Gear:

- A van will be available to transport competitor gear from the Start Line area to the Summit.

Summit Photos:

- We will be staging podiums on the Summit for competitors to take individual or provisional podium finish photos after their runs. We encourage competitors to post any photos they take on social media. Don't forget to tag @pikespeakhillclimb (or @ppihc for Twitter) and use #PPIHC2020.

Internet:

- If you have a smartphone or other mobile device, internet will be available (for purchase) at the Summit.

Phones:

- Competitors are encouraged to send their mobile device in the gear transportation van. Although not guaranteed, service at the Summit is more reliable than other places on the Mountain. Competitors can use their phones to communicate with family and friends and capture podium photos.
