



025 – COVID-19 Precautions and Guidelines

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(Subject to Change)

Below is a summary of COVID protocols that will be in place for the 2020 PPIHC's August racing footprint that includes Testing on August 7, 9, 14, 15 & 16, Practice/Qualifying on August 25, 26, 27 & 28 and Race Day on August 30, 2020.

The PPIHC will be working to follow all federal, state, and local policies regarding COVID-19. We want to reassure all competitors that the safety and well-being of everyone involved is our primary concern. The information below contains precautions and guidelines that the PPIHC is implementing as well as new rules and protocol for competitors, crew, and all credentialed individuals.

Please review this carefully and adhere to all guidelines outlined below:

Hand Sanitizer and Face Coverings provided by UCHealth

- Due to our long-term partnership with UCHealth, they are able to provide the following:
 - Hand Sanitizer for all credentialed individuals
 - Face Coverings will be provided to each individual who passes through the Gateway each day of Testing, Practice and Race Day.

Competitors and Crew

- All credentialed individuals will review and sign an online symptom agreement outlining the policies below and agreeing to abide by the policies set forth by the organizers based on information from local and state health departments.
- Competitors are encouraged to wear a face mask or cloth face covering at all times while engaging with any individual, unless they can consistently maintain 6' social distancing from others. Competitors are not required to wear a face mask or cloth face covering while they are in their racecar or while racing/competing.
- Daily on-course meetings will be conducted via a megaphone and competitors will be encouraged to maintain a 6' distance from each other.

- Competitors and crew members are to remain in their designated pit area when possible and not congregate with other teams, competitors or other crew members at any time.

Paddock Parking/Pit Area:

- All competitors will be given a pit space in the PPIHC pit area for their competition vehicle. Some pit spaces may have an empty pit area adjacent or next to it. This area is to remain clear at all times to allow for social distancing and to separate competitors. At no time may this area be used by any competitor as an extra pit space. No vehicles or equipment may be placed in these areas.
- Competitors and crew members are to remain in their designated pit area when possible and not congregate with other teams, competitors, or crew members.

Credential Check/Entrance:

- This will take place at the Gateway of Pikes Peak – America’s Mountain.
- Drive-through entrance only; everyone will remain in their vehicle.
- Staff will be required to use gloves and face masks.
- Competitors/Credentialed personnel will have previously been given Release of Liability Waiver forms to sign and hand to staff at the Gateway.
- Please have all crew members and their credentials easily visibly to expedite entry.

Starting Line/Takeoff Point:

- A ‘limited access’ gate and a ‘no access beyond this point’ gate/entrance will be in place as the competitors move toward the Takeoff Point.
- Once through the “no access” gate only two (2) members from the competitor’s crew will be allowed at the Takeoff Point. These members must have the competitors numbered pass in order to enter the Takeoff Point.
- Any credentialed individual in the limited access area or Takeoff Point will be asked to wear a face mask or a cloth face covering.

Finish Line:

- The number of Finish Line area personnel will be extremely limited to only essential personnel and credentialed individuals.
- All credentialed individuals will be advised to limit group gatherings to no more than 10 people.
- The Summit House will be open to Competitors for safety and for a meal. The PPIHC will follow all/any guidelines Pikes Peak – America’s Mountain has regarding table alignment and protocols regarding social distancing and food service. If no policy is in place, the PPIHC will implement 25% of stated capacity, up to a maximum of 50 people, with appropriate signage and markings to encourage social distancing.
- All competitors will be given a disposable face mask once they exit their vehicle after finishing the race. Competitors will be encouraged to wear a

- face mask or cloth face covering at all times, unless they can consistently maintain 6' social distancing from others.
- PPIHC film crews/select media will be allowed to do post-race interviews with competitors using microphones/boom poles that allow for the competitor and interviewer to be 6' apart.
 - Media will be asked to wear face masks or cloth face coverings when interacting with competitors. Competitors will not be allowed to touch/hold the microphone during interviews.

Pre-Race Related Proceedings and Trainings

The following pre-race trainings are mandatory and will be conducted virtually, not in person:

- Drivers Training
- Rookie Orientation

Competitor Registration – Monday, August 24, 2020

- Competitor Registration will take place outdoors at Technical Inspection in the parking lot of the Broadmoor World Arena on August 24, 2020.
- All Individuals will be advised to wear a face mask or cloth face covering during Registration and packet pick up.
- All competitors will have previously submitted all required documentation via email to avoid any physical exchange onsite.
- No products/credentials will be sold onsite. All additional crew credentials (limited to two (2) per team) are to be pre-purchased online to avoid cash handling/exchange.
- Competitor packets will include multiple masks along with hand sanitizer.
- Competitors will sign the Release of Liability Waiver with disposable/sanitized pens only.
- Competitors may only register during their pre-assigned time slot. Each registration line will be spaced at least 6' apart.
- Only competitors will be allowed in the Registration area. No spouse/family, crew or friends.
- Only one (1) competitor will be allowed at the Registration check-in table at a time. All others will adhere to the 6' social distancing policy while in line.
- Each line will have marks 6' apart to encourage social distancing.
- Competitor Registration area will have an opposite entrance and exit to increase flow and reduce participants passing each other as they wait in line.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at all points of contact between competitors and staff.
- No less than once every hour, staff will sanitize all surfaces in the packet pick up area.

Technical Inspection – Monday, August 24, 2020

- Will take place outdoors in the parking lot of the Broadmoor World Arena and will not be open to the general public.
- All individuals be advised to wear a face mask or cloth face covering during all aspects of Technical Inspection.
- Hand sanitizer will be available for all officials and competitors.
- A schedule will be in place for each competitor to move through Technical Inspection at a pre-assigned time. Competitors may only go through Technical Inspection during their pre-assigned time slot.
- Competitors and crew members will be instructed to remain with their vehicle at all times and not congregate with other teams, competitors, or crew members. No crew members are allowed in the Registration area. No crew members are allowed to attend Technical Inspection outside of the designated time slot. After the car has completed Technical Inspection, all crew members must leave the area.
