Summit Visitor Center:

- The brand new Summit Visitor Center will be open to competitors to receive their meal as well as explore the exhibits.
- The Visitor Center will be open to Competitors for shelter and a meal. When inside, face coverings are mandatory.
- The Visitors Center will also be open to tourists who are using the Cog Railway. Please be courteous to these tourists.

Food:

- All PPIHC competitors will be provided a meal courtesy of Aramark.
- The Visitor Center kitchen staff will have a full competitor list and will provide one meal per competitor on Race Day.

HARL Building

- The HARL building will be made available to all PPIHC competitors on Race Day and will serve as the Competitor Hospitality area.
- TVs will be stationed in the Harl building, displaying live results.
- The HARL Building is for competitors only, no media.

Media:

- PPIHC film crews/select media will be allowed to do post-race interviews with competitors while abiding by all COVID guidelines.

Gear:

- A van will be available to transport competitor gear from the Start Line area to the Summit.

Summit Photos:

- We will be staging podiums on the Summit for competitors to take individual or provisional podium finish photos after their runs. We encourage competitors to post any photos they take on social media. Don't forget to tag @pikespeakhillclimb (or @ppihc

for Twitter) and use #PPIHC2021. Include #PikesPeakSummit to be included on the new summit interpretive wall.

Internet:

- If you have a smartphone or other mobile device, internet will be available (for purchase) at the Summit.

Phones:

- Competitors are encouraged to send their mobile device in the gear transportation van. Although not guaranteed, service at the Summit is more reliable than other places on the mountain. Competitors may use their phones to communicate with family and friends and capture podium photos.
