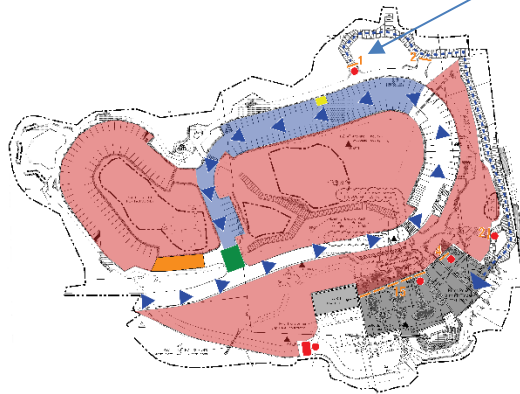
Summit Visitor Center:

- The brand new Visitor Center will be open to Competitors for shelter and a meal.
- The competitors will also be able to explore the exhibits.
- The Visitors Center will also be open to tourists who are using the Cog Railway. Please be courteous to these tourists.

Summit Map:

- While the Visitor Center is scheduled to be open, construction at the summit continues. Space is extremely limited. Blue arrows indicate the plan for competitor parking on race day. To access the Visitor Center walk to the north sidewalk (indicated by “•1” below) and follow the walkway around the summit to the building.

Food:

- All PPIHC competitors will be provided a meal courtesy of Aramark.
- The Visitor Center kitchen is not fully functional, so box lunches will be served. Staff will have a full competitor list and will provide one meal per competitor on Race Day.

Competitor Hospitality Area

- The restaurant area in the Visitors Center building will be made available to all PPIHC competitors on Race Day and will serve as the Competitor Hospitality area.
- TVs will be stationed in the dining area, displaying live results.

Media:

- PPIHC film crews/select media will be allowed to do post-race interviews with competitors.

Gear:

- A van will be available to transport competitor gear from the Start Line area to the Summit.

Summit Photos:

- We will be staging podiums on the Summit for competitors to take individual or provisional podium finish photos after their runs. We encourage competitors to post any photos they take on social media. Don't forget to tag @pikespeakhillclimb (or @ppihc for Twitter) and use #PPIHC2021. Include #PikesPeakSummit to be included on the new summit interpretive wall.

Internet:

- If you have a smartphone or other mobile device, internet will be available at the Summit.

Phones:

- Competitors are encouraged to send their mobile device in the gear transportation van. Although not guaranteed, service at the Summit is more reliable than other places on the mountain. Competitors may use their phones to communicate with family and friends and capture podium photos.
