Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, there will not be an awards ceremony following the 2020 event. All competitors will have the opportunity to come to our office for a photo op with their awards, as well as to sign commemorative checkered flags.

Competitors may pickup their awards:

- August 31st: 7:30am – 4:30pm
- September 1-2nd: 9:00am – 4:00pm

If a competitor is unable to come to our office, their award will be mailed out following the August 30th event.

Awards:

The PPIHC is pleased to collaborate with Colorado Springs-based Glassical Designs to produce crystal trophies featuring the original Penrose Trophy design from the inaugural 1916 race. In addition to the crystal trophies, the following awards will be presented:

Watches:

Rebellion Timepieces, the PPIHC's Official Timekeeper, will award a Twenty-One 3 Hands Watch, valued at over \$5,000, to the winner of each division (with the exception of the Porsche Pikes Peak Trophy By Yokohama division) in the 98th running of the Race to the Clouds. The watch supplier for the Porsche Division will be supplied by Porsche Designs.

Cash Purse:

The cash purse for the 2020 Race will be \$75,000. The 2020 purse allocation was approved by the PPIHC Board of Directors with the following breakdown:

- \$5,000.00 will be distributed to the King of the Mountain.
- \$45,000.00 will be distributed evenly between the purse-eligible divisions based on the number of participants in a division.
- \$25,000.00 will be split among any competitor(s) breaking the eight minute thirty second mark (8:29.999 or faster) with a maximum of \$10,000.00 going to an individual entry.
- ***NOTE: All percentage based purse allocations will be determined based on the number of eligible entries that cross the Start Line on Race Day (8/30/2020).***

***Previous Records** - Competitors must declare a record attempt prior to Tech Inspection and meet all competition rules for former classes as stated in the Appendix of the 2020 PPIHC Rule Book.

DEFINITION OF TERMS:

Division - The foundation of the competition structure, wherein various entries and vehicle types are separated by established rules and specifications.

The number of places paid in each eligible division will be determined by the number of eligible entries that cross the Start Line on Race Day. The parameters listing how many places will be paid for a division, based on the divisions allocation of the purse, is as follows:

Divisions with 3 or less competitors pay out 2 places. ¹
Divisions with 4-9 competitors pay out 3 places.
Divisions with 10-15 competitors pay out 4 places.
Divisions with 16-21 competitors pay out 5 places.
Divisions with 22+ competitors pay out 6 places.
