Practice, Qualifying, and Race Day

Pikes Peak – America's Mountain has been working endlessly in order to have the Summit ready for Race Week, while still trying to finish construction on the new Visitor Center (set for a soft opening on Thursday, June 24). Everything is on track, and we are confident that competitors in the upper section will be able to run to the Summit. However, everyone must be cautious near the finish. The area at the Summit immediately following the checkered flag is significantly narrower than in past years. The transition at the checkered flag from pavement to dirt happens quickly and road conditions vary significantly. Please use extreme caution.

In addition to these specific concerns at the Summit, competitors **MUST** slow down after receiving the checkered flag in all sections. Failure to do so could result in a PPIHC fine and/or penalty.
