



2026 Request for Invitation Checklist

As you prepare to complete and submit the Request for Invitation documentation via the PPIHC website, the following items will be required for upload when you submit your request. All documentation must be submitted by 5:00pm MST on January 29, 2026 for the Selection Committee to consider your request. Accepted, waitlisted and denied competitors will be identified during the selection process. All competitors must complete the Request for Invitation and provide all information listed below in order to be considered for an invitation.

☐ **Completed Request for Invitation**

(online submissions only)

☐ **Payment**

(due with Request for Invitation)

Fee for the 2026 PPIHC is \$4,500 per entry. This price includes the cost of mandatory in-car vehicle tracking. If you do not receive an invitation to compete in the 2026 race, your payment will be refunded.

☐ **Photo of Vehicle**

(due with Request for Invitation)

All competitors must submit a photograph or rendering of the vehicle as it is to be raced.

(If your vehicle is new to Pikes Peak, please upload additional vehicle build documentation and/or photos of your roll cage, vehicle interior and frame.)

☐ **Racing Resume/Expert Licenses**

(due with Request for Invitation)

All competitors must upload a current and complete racing resume with their Request for Invitation. The Selection Committee will base their evaluation upon the vehicle information provided AND this racing resume. The resume must include PPIHC racing history for all veteran PPIHC competitors. An example of a racing resume can be found [HERE](#). Resumes should include any current professional racing licenses held by the competitor.

☐ **Racing References**

(due with Request for Invitation)

All rookie competitors and veteran competitors who have not competed in the PPIHC in the past 5 years must submit three references who can verify their professional racing experience, history and background with the Request for Invitation. All references must include: name, relationship to competitor, phone number and e-mail.

☐ **Head Shot/Personal Photograph**

(due with Request for Invitation)

All competitors must submit a recent, professional-looking headshot with the entrant's face clearly visible. No selfies are allowed. Photographs including helmets and/or props are not allowed. The ideal size of the photo is 5" x 7" with a resolution of at least 360 X 504 pixels. Lower resolution images will appear blurry in the race program. Acceptable photo examples can be found [HERE](#). These photos will be used in the Official PPIHC Race Program, as well as in any relevant press releases or social media posts.

----- **Vehicle Information/Division Specific Entries** -----

When completing the Request for Invitation, the following division and vehicle-specific information is required:

Exhibition

(due with Request for Invitation)

☐ Vehicle Description

Electric Vehicles

(due with Request for Invitation)

☐ All electric/hybrid vehicle entries must be accompanied by the MSDS information for all batteries that are considered hazardous or toxic.

Time Attack 1

(due with Request for Invitation)

☐ All vehicles in the Time Attack 1 division must provide the VIN number of their vehicle. If no VIN number can be provided, a build sheet from the manufacturer must be submitted.

Production Records

(due with Request for Invitation)

☐ All vehicles competing for a Production Record (Production Car, Production SUV/Crossover, Production Truck/Van, Electric Production Car, Electric Production SUV/Crossover, Electric Production Truck/Van), must provide the VIN number of their vehicle as well as documentation of how the vehicle's airbag was removed or disabled.

Roll Cage Specifications/Certifications

(due with Request for Invitation)

☐ Any roll cage that does not meet the minimum weight per material specifications defined in the chart shown in 105.2 of the 2026 PPIHC Rule Book and/or has a certification that is not recognized by the PPIHC, must be accompanied by documentation during the Request for Invitation process.

Vehicles originally built for Pikes Peak's traditional dirt racing surface (due with Request for Invitation)

☐ Vehicles originally built for Pikes Peak's traditional dirt racing surface will be required to list all modifications that have been made to make the vehicle suitable to race on the current paved surface.
