



PPIHC Code of Conduct for all Credentialed Personnel

Thank you for supporting The Pikes Peak International Hill Climb. All PPIHC credentialed personal and ticket holders are required to refrain from the following:

- Behavior that is unruly, disruptive, dangerous or illegal in nature.
- Intoxication or other signs of alcohol or substance impairment that results in irresponsible behavior.
- Interference with the event.
- Failure to follow instructions of PPIHC personal or law enforcement.
- Theft or vandalism.
- Smoking
- Bringing prohibited items onto Pikes Peak – America’s Mountain
 - Firearms
 - Pets (not including service animals)
 - Fireworks
 - Drones
- Offensive language or obscene gestures directed toward a person’s race, ethnicity, gender, religion, disability, age, sexual orientation, gender identity / expression; or to instigate, incite or encourage a confrontation or physical assault.
